Re: Northern California Region 6 NPSPAC Repacking and Rebanding Meeting

On May 25, 2006 a meeting will be held in Sacramento, California hosted by the Region 6 Review and Revision Committee. The meeting will be between representatives of the 800 MHz Transition Administrator, Sprint Nextel and all licensees whose frequencies are proposed to change under the amended Region 6 plan. Members of the Regional Committee will also be present to answer any questions.

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss necessary steps to incorporate the amended Region 6 plan into 800 MHz Band Reconfiguration. **Please see the enclosed letter from Region 6 Review and Revision Chairman, Art McDole, which provides more details on the purpose and goals of the meeting.**

Licensees are requested to come to the meeting with detailed information on their "to and from" frequency plans based on the amended Region 6 plan. The information should be listed by call sign and each licensed location on the call sign. This information should include the call sign; the location number, address and coordinates and; the currently licensed frequency and the frequency to which it will be changing under the amended Region 6 plan. Having this information in an Excel file on a CD or memory stick would be greatly appreciated. The file name should identify the licensee.

Your attendance and participation in this meeting is critical to ensure successful inclusion of Region 6 repacking in 800 MHz Reconfiguration.
